Following the Sunday you join, we will write the church holding your membership and request a transfer. Christian baptism from other denominations is honored so you will not be baptized again.

What if I am not a member of any church, but have been baptized?

You will be joining by profession of faith answering the vows of church membership.

What if I've never been baptized?

You will be baptized when you join and make a profession of faith.

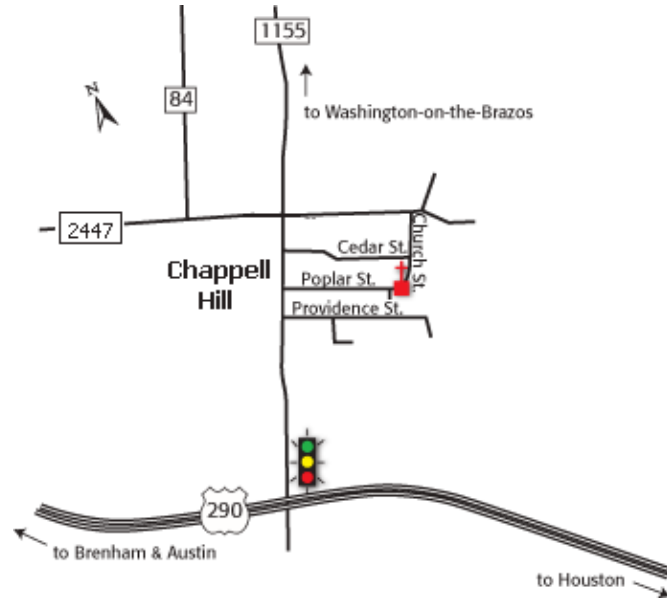
